KCU signs MOU with HESFS to expand access to student financing

King Ceasor University has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Higher Education Students' Financing Scheme (HESFS) to expand access to higher education financing for eligible students.

The agreement was signed on 20th May 2026 in Kampala by Dr. Charity Basaza Mulenga, Vice Chancellor of King Ceasor University, together with representatives from HESFS and the Ministry.

Through this partnership, eligible KCU students will be able to access government-supported loans to support tuition and functional fees, reinforcing the university's commitment to accessible and inclusive education.
